The minutes from the December 31, 2020 special meeting were reviewed and a motion to approve them was made by Thomas Stull and supported by Katelin Makay. Vote, all yes.

The Clerk received correspondence that the township was chosen to participate in a Risk Limiting Audit for the November election to be completed by January 20th at 5:00pm.

The Clerk submitted a listing of current bills and motion to approve them for payment was made by Matt Kusmack and supported by Thomas Stull. Vote, all yes.

The Treasurer submitted her December reports, and they were reviewed and motion to accept them was made by Katie Hartwell and supported by Kevin Kusmack. Vote, all yes.

The Supervisor gave his report, which included an update from the fire board.

The County Commissioner's report included changes made to the jail to maintain safety and security for prisoner visitations and consultations, a new appointee to the Road Commission, and an update on COVID-19 vaccines offered by the Health Department.

There were no reports from Zoning Administrator or Senior Activities.

Van Buren Sheriff Department report was given and there were no questions.

The Supervisor presented the recommendations for road improvement projects that will be presented to the Road Commission for their review.
